

Cider house claims a gong for top brew

A PENINSULA boutique cider house has taken out the top prize for one of its new brews.

Main Ridge wine and cider producer Rebello claimed gold at the Royal Melbourne Fine Food Awards for its Methode Traditionelle Cider. The team behind Cheeky Rascal Cider, Australia's only 100 per cent real fruit blended ciders, spent months in development before launching its Methode range last November.

Rebello's chief executive

Ruth Gallace said the award was validation of the expertise, time and resources that went into the product.

"We had never attempted anything like this before, so to be awarded gold by the Royal Melbourne Fine Food Awards against other very established cider houses is very rewarding," she said.

Ms Gallace said the result, made from local Granny Smith apples, is a product with "fine champagne-like bubbles, which is semi-dry and delicate".
