**Comments** Cheeky Rascal Honey Apple Limited Edition Cyser is very sweet and extremely strong. Cyser, so the bottle tells us, is the swanky name for when honey and apple juice are 'co-fermented'. After the initial bombard of the sweet artillery the orange blossom and manuka honey take centre stage making the cyser almost floral in flavour. It's a little beery on the nose but one sip will cure you of that delusion. The aftertaste is lingering and sugary but provided you don't mind a sweet drop it's no problem. Cheeky's Cyser is nice for a single drink but a bit full on for any kind of prolonged drinking session. It seems that Cheeky Rascal's monopoly on super strong, very sweet drinks is firmly intact with their 'limited edition' Honey Apple Cyser. So limited... it doesn't appear on their website, but is widely available in large supermarket-owned retailers. Controversial in this reviewing session, we've had to settle on agreeing to disagree.
